

SCHOOL PLANS/SITE COUNCILS

The Board of Trustees encourages employees, students, parents/guardians and other members of the school community to develop school plans designed to meet the specific needs at individual school sites. The Board may approve or disapprove school plans as necessary in order to fulfill the district's mission, accomplish the Board's adopted goals and/or comply with legal requirements.

When submitting a consolidated application for state and federal categorical programs to the California Department of Education, the Superintendent or designee shall assure that a single plan for student achievement has been prepared for Neil Cummins and Hall in accordance with law. (Education Code 64001)

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that Neil Cummins and Hall establish and maintain a school site council. Such councils shall be responsible for the development, review and modification of school plans and for other duties as prescribed by law.
