

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANCE

Duties of Volunteers

Volunteers may assist with all duties that do not replace, on a regular basis, the normal duties of classified staff.

Volunteers may work on short-term facilities projects.

Qualifications of Volunteers

A person who is required to register as a sex offender pursuant to Penal Code 290 shall not serve as a volunteer. (Education Code 35021) The Superintendent or designee shall verify by reasonable means that persons serving as volunteers are not registered as a sex offender pursuant to Penal Code 290.

No volunteer shall be assigned to provide supervision or instruction of students unless he/she has submitted evidence of an examination within the past 60 days to determine that he/she is free of active tuberculosis. Volunteers who skin test negative shall thereafter be required to take a tuberculosis test every four years in accordance with Education Code 49406. (Education Code 45106, 45347, 45349, 49406)
