

SOLICITATION OF FUNDS FROM AND BY STUDENTS

The Board of Trustees recognizes that student participation in fund-raising activities for the schools can help develop a sense of social responsibility in students, enhance the relationship between the school and community, and contribute to the improvement of the school program.

When solicitations are made on behalf of the school, students shall not be barred from an event or activity because they did not participate in fund-raising. Potential donors, including parents/guardians and members of the community, should not be unduly pressured to contribute to the school system or charitable organizations. Staff is expected to emphasize the fact that donations are always voluntary and that students are to follow their parents' guidance on who to solicit and who not to solicit.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that parents/guardians are informed of the purpose of fund-raisers.
