

## **TRANSPORTATION FAQ'S**

### ***Why don't all students ride free?***

Marin County Transit District eliminated the ride and roll program that allowed school aged youths to ride for free. There is now one youth fare, which is \$1 per trip.

### ***Can all students from East Corte Madera ride the bus?***

Yes, all students can choose to ride the bus, but students must have either: a pass from the school district, a ticket, or the \$1 fare.

### ***What about students who do not live in East Corte Madera but who may want to ride the bus from Corte Madera to Hall Middle School?***

These students may ride the bus for \$1 per trip. Neil Cummins and Hall Schools will have tickets available for purchase in the office for students who need to ride the bus on an occasional basis.

### ***What does the Larkspur School District pay for the bus?***

The Larkspur School District does not pay for the bus. The district must reimburse MCTD for those students for whom a pass has been granted. MCTD will charge an annual rate of \$350 for each child who rides the bus to and from school every day.

### ***Who is eligible to receive a pass from the district?***

Students who reside in east Corte Madera and ride the bus on a daily basis will be granted a pass.

### ***The bus for students at Neil Cummins does not come right after school. Will there be supervision provided for these students?***

Yes. Neil Cummins will provide supervision for students waiting for the bus. There will be a crossing guard at the Corte Madera Rec Center as well.

### ***When the new routes begin on Sept 12, will there be an early bus for the early release day at Neil Cummins?***

Unfortunately, there will not be an early bus on Wednesdays for students at Neil Cummins. Parents will need to arrange for transportation on that day. MCTD eliminated all routes that had fewer than 20 riders.
