**What are the current enrollment projections?**

A chart indicating enrollment trends can be found on the Larkspur School District website, [www.larkspurschools.org](http://www.larkspurschools.org). The projections are based on historical enrollment and attrition data, housing turnover rates, and county census and demographic projections. The projections indicate a slow growth rate between 2007-2011 at which point growth stabilizes at approximately 1250-1300 students.

**Why doesn't Larkspur School District open one of its closed schools?**

Both of the "closed schools" are significant revenue producers for the District but are not "up-to-current-ed-code" for occupation by a public school. District studies on cost estimates for opening either facility exceed \$12,000,000, not to mention the additional costs associated with on-site administration. Neither the enrollment trends nor financial capacity of the District, not to mention public sentiment, are persuasive in support of any such opening.

**When will Trustees make a decision on the ELF Committee's recommendations?**

Any decision would be made no sooner than the July Board meeting, but most probably before school starts in August.
